This report covers the fund's first year, from December 1, 2022, to November 30, 2023. During this period, the Savoy-Pitfield Family and 55 other donors generously contributed cash and future commitments totalling more than \$200,000. As a result, 21 loans were disbursed to 20 Rise clients aged 16-34. The total value of these

loans is \$108,290.

#### **ABOUT RISE**



Through training, mentorship, micro-financing, and other customs supports, Rise helps individuals build the skills and access the capital they need to build a small business that can improve their quality of life and enable them to support themselves, their families and their communities.

Since its founding in 2010, Rise has disbursed 900 loans totalling over \$3.7 million and helped to empower 4,500 individuals from coast to coast as entrepreneurs.


# MARSHALL PITFIELD YOUTH LOAN FUND YEAR ONE: KEY STATISTICS

This chart illustrates the distribution of loan amounts given to Marshall Pitfield Youth Loan Fund clients.


The average loan size is \$5,157.



# GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION



# GENDER DISTRIBUTION


Half of Marshall Pitfield Youth Loan Fund clients identify as female.





### **CLIENT DIVERSITY**

There is a great deal of diversity among Marshall Pitfield Youth Loan Fund clients—40% are racialized; 15% identify as 2SLGBTQI+.

Rise clients often establish businesses with minimal start-up expenses, commonly operating them from home or online.

Notably, a substantial portion of these businesses fall within the health and wellness sector, reflecting the passion and expertise of individuals with a history of mental health or addiction challenges.
