Mentors provide one-on-one business advice to Rise lending clients during **one-hour monthly meetings**, with periodic phone and e-mail support as needed.

• Total time commitment: 2 to 4 hours monthly for 12 months.

Become a Youth Small Business Program Coach

Virtual & in-person opportunities available across Ontario

As a <u>Youth Small Business Program</u> (YSBP) coach, you will use your expertise to help teach practical business skills to aspiring young entrepreneurs in Ontario and support them as they develop business plans.

YSBP coaches provide **three**, **one-on-one in-person business coaching sessions** with program participants over a 10-week period.

YSBP coaches also attend **three**, **two-hour group business coaching sessions**, as well as a **two-hour pitch event and graduation ceremony** at the end of the program.

*Please note that our one-on-one sessions are currently suspended due to the pandemic. All group business coaching sessions and the pitch event/graduation are conducted virtually.

• **Total time commitment per program cohort:** 6 hours in-class + 2 hours for pitch and graduation event.

Become an EnterpRISEing Youth Plus Coach

Virtual opportunities available with Rise across Canada

Share your expertise and experience as a coach with our virtual <u>EnterpRISEing Youth Plus</u> <u>Program</u> (EY+) to help aspiring young entrepreneurs learn business basics and develop their plans to launch real-life enterprises.

EY+ coaches attend **three, two-hour group business coaching sessions** over an 8-week period, providing guidance and support to groups of 1 - 4 program participants.

EY+ coaches also attend a **two-hour virtual pitch event and graduation ceremony** at the end of the program.

• **Total time commitment per program cohort:** 6 hours in-class + 2 hours for pitch and graduation event (all virtual).

Become a Peer Supported Startup Program Coach

Virtual & in-person opportunities available with Rise Toronto and Rise Mississauga The <u>Peer Supported Startup Program</u> (PSSP) is an opportunity to not only contribute as a business coach, but also as a member of a larger peer network. As a PSSP coach, you will attend in-class sessions and provide support to a group of adult entrepreneurs working together to develop plans for launching and/or growing their individual small businesses.

PSSP coaches provide support to groups of 3 to 6 program participants, **attending four**, **twohour group business coaching sessions** over an 8-week period.

PSSP coaches also attend a **two-hour pitch event and graduation ceremony** at the end of the program.

*Please note that all PSSP program components are currently run virtually.

• **Total time commitment per program cohort:** 8 hours in-class + 2 hours for pitch and graduation event

Become a My Start-Up Coach

Opportunities available in Toronto

Run in partnership with the Elizabeth Fry Toronto, as a <u>My Start-Up Program</u> coach you will help provide entrepreneurship training support to women in need who want to start their own small businesses.

My Startup coaches attend **six**, **two-hour group business coaching sessions** over the course of an 8-week period.

My Start-Up coaches also attend a **two-hour pitch event and graduation ceremony** at the end of the program.

• Total time commitment per program cohort: 12 hours in-class + 2 hours for pitch and graduation event

Become a Loan Review Committee Member

Virtual & in-person opportunities available across Canada

The Rise Loan Review Committee (LRC) is responsible for adjudicating loans above \$2,500 disbursed as a part of our Small Business Lending Program. As a volunteer Loan Review Committee Member, you will provide guidance and advice on how Rise loans are distributed based on business plans submitted by clients.

LRC members spend **2** - **4** hours per month reviewing business plans, and must attend one monthly committee meeting (2 - 4 hours) via video call.

• Total time commitment: 4 to 8 hours monthly for 12 months.
