This is a part-time (100 hours from September to February, with potential for extension, at \$25/hour) position for a Toronto-based student to conduct research in preparation for our 2025-2028 strategic planning process. You will play a vital role in collecting, analyzing, and synthesizing data on both internal operations and the broader external landscape. This research will help inform the organization's strategic priorities and guide decision-making for the next three years.

This position is ideal for a student in the fields of nonprofit management, public policy, business, sociology, environmental studies, or related disciplines with a strong interest in research, strategy, and community development.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- External (Macro) Environment Analysis: Conduct a PESTEL analysis (Political, Economic, Social, Technological, Environmental, Legal) relevant to Rise's sector and mission.
- Stakeholder and Sector Analysis: Map key stakeholders (funders, partners, clients, government bodies, community groups) and assess their interests, expectations, and influence.
- **Internal Organizational Analysis:** Assist in reviewing the organization's mission, vision, and values for alignment and clarity.

- Data Collection: Develop and administer surveys and questionnaires for internal and external stakeholders.
- **Synthesis and Reporting:** Draft a comprehensive environmental scan report, summarizing external trends, Internal strengths and challenges; and strategic opportunities and threats

- Enrolled in a post-secondary program, ideally in public policy, nonprofit management, business, social sciences, or related fields

- Demonstrated ability to synthesize complex information
